Reference

- Find an encyclopedia set. In the L volume locate information about C. S. Lewis. When did he live? Where did he live? Write down the title of one of his nonfiction books. Write down the title of his famous children's book series.
- Find the word "license" in a dictionary. Write down two definitions for the word.
- Find the country of Mauritania in a World Atlas. What natural resources can be found there?



Nonfiction

- Find the shelf where books about history can be found. Locate a book about the war of 1812. Who was President? What was the fight about.
- Find the shelf where books about fairy tales can be found. Write down the title of a fairy tale that is new to you.
- Find the shelf where books about inventions can be found. Locate a book about the printing press. Who invented it? Where? When?



Fiction

- Locate a book by your favorite author. What is the title and author of the book that comes before it on the shelf? What is the title and author of the book that comes after it on the shelf?
- How many books written by L. M. Montgomery are on the shelf?
- Ask the Library if there is a shelf for the Newbery Award books. Find one and write down the title, author, and copyright date.



Periodical

- In the periodicals section, locate a newspaper. Write down the publication date and the headline.
- How many different craft magazines are there?
- Choose a magazine that looks interesting to you and write down one of the articles in it you would like to read.
